I'm currently updating this question because it turns out you don't have to clean install the game, but you can reset your system and force reinstall the game. I've included links to my guide below. Follow the steps below and do them all. You will be doing this for 2 hours, but it should only take you a half hour. And once it's done, you'll see the game work perfectly. 1. Reset your computer - this will be a major pain, and I've included a guide below to help. 2. Close all running applications and games, and reboot your computer. 3. Once you're on your desktop, open up your Start menu. Then go to Control Panel. Under Control Panel, go to Programs and Features. 4. Click on Administrative Tools 5. Click on Services and Applications 6. Choose Restart. 7. Wait for the computer to reboot. 8. Open Steam. Then go into the games library. You should see L.A. Noire in there. Go to your download folder, and make sure there's an L.A. Noire folder. Delete this folder if you see it. 9. Open Steam. Click on your Profile, and then click on the Games tab. Click on Local Files. 10. Click on Verify Integrity of Game Cache Files. 11. Wait for the verification to finish. 12. Open Steam again, and click on the Game tab. Then click on Downloads. 13. Right click on L.A. Noire, and select Delete Local Content. 14. Now select Reinstall Steam Client (if you haven't already). 15. Go to Steam and restart your computer. When Steam restarts, it will have to download your game again, but it should be fine this time. 16. Close Steam. 17. Open L.A. Noire, and it should work.
